

EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Big Brothers Big Sisters Foundation Scholarship Program was established to assist:

- a graduating high school senior who is a current/former Little Brother or Little Sister of the Big Brothers Big Sisters of Central California affiliate
- continuing college student who is a current/former Little Brother or Little Sister of the Big Brothers Big Sisters of Central California affiliate
- a current High School Big of the Big Brothers Big Sisters of Central California affiliate that is in good standing; and seeking college or trade school tuition support
- a former High School Big of the Big Brothers Big Sisters of Central California affiliate that is/ was in good standing; and seeking college or trade school tuition support

Since the inception of the scholarship program, successful candidates have been awarded educational scholarships ranging from \$250 - \$1,000 each.

Any eligible participant in the Big Brothers Big Sisters of Central California (BBBSCC) program must submit this application to the agency no later than **Friday**, **March 1**, **2024**.

Applications will be carefully screened and reviewed by a scholarship selection committee. Successful candidates will be notified of their award by the end of the current spring semester. Successful candidates will be encouraged to attend a scholarship recipient luncheon to accept their award and meet the donors.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Must be a <u>current/former</u> Little Brother or Little Sister in the Community Based Mentoring program administered by Big Brothers Big Sisters of Central California OR a <u>current/former</u> Big in the High School Big program OR a <u>current</u> Big in the Community Based Program
- Must be accepted to an accredited college (junior college/four-year institution/trade school).
- Undergraduate
- Must carry a minimum of 12 units, or 9 units if working full-time (employment must be verified).
- Must maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA
